ACCOMMODATIONS: Great primitive/tent camping sites on 20 acres. Outhouse and porta-potties will be provided. Bring your own drinking water. We have plenty of water in the cistern. Level sites are available for trailers/motor homes/campers, but no hook-ups.

FOOD: Let's potluck for Saturday night. We will establish campfire areas. Stove is available for heating/cooking. If you don't want to cook, you may forego a potluck dish but bring a contribution for shared breakfast.

WE'RE EXCITED TO HAVE YOU BECAUSE: The first building of Sand Canyon House is under construction and we hope to have the solar system in place to power the sound system for the stage. This is a spectacular site, with world-class views. Sand Canyon Pueblo is our closest neighbor. Sand Canyon trail (6.5 mi.) begins here and ends in McElmo Canyon. BLM land is just west of us – so there is great biking and hiking to add to the music scene.

The future of a truly great music festival starts with this gathering! We hope you can be a part of the grass roots/core group that will return again and again to share this extraordinary place with Mike and I.

DIRECTIONS TO SAND CANYON HOUSE MUSIC FESTIVAL FROM CORTEZ

We are about 15 miles from Cortez. 9.4 miles of this is traveling on county roads, starting with the turn onto CR P.

- Travel North on Hwy. 491 going towards Dove Creek, CO
- About 5 miles North of Cortez turn Left/West on CR P
- Travel this paved county road until it comes to a T (4 mi. or so)
- At this point you will be at P.5 and Rd. 18
- Turn Left/South and the road will continue past these landmarks:
 - Goodman Point Cemetery (on Left)
 - Lewis-Arriola Fire Station (on Left)
 - The little red schoolhouse, now a residence (on Right)
- You are still on CR P but it will end at the junction of Rd. 16
- Turn Left/South onto Rd. 16 (Going straight at this point would bring you on the farm of county commissioner, Steve Chappell)
- Go approximately 1 mi. to the next road – there is no stop sign but you will be at the junction of Rd. 16 and CR N
- You will know you are almost there because you will see the official “Sand Canyon Pueblo” sign pointing to the right
- Turn Right/West onto CR N and travel 1.4 mi. to the Festival site on top of the hill. You will pass Sand Canyon Pueblo/Canyons of the Ancients parking area on the Left and can see our property “one hill away”. We are on the Left side of the road (14980 CR N). You can't miss our “curiously large” concrete wall – an inherited part of the property!
